So what does this mean?

We will undertake all reasonably practicable steps to prevent harm from occurring to clubs members and their health, safety and welfare will be actively promoted by:

- Identifying, assessing and controlling all existing and new risks in the environment, to which clubs members and others are or may be exposed;
- Providing information, training and equipment appropriate for controlling those risks assessed as being significant; and
- Having a comprehensive and up-to-date plan for all emergencies.

Executives/Committees will work in partnership with club members and ensure that all club members have the opportunity to participate in the above process, and will respond promptly to all health and safety concerns raised.

Club Members will meet their responsibilities by taking all reasonably practicable steps to ensure their own and others health and safety, and are encouraged to become actively involved in assisting their Executive/Committee to achieve a healthy and safe club environment. Club members will co-operate and report risks and other sub-standard conditions, incidents/accidents and near misses, to their Club Executive/Committee.
